### **CHAIRMAN**

Victor D'Ambrosio discussed the following:

Deferred updates to the Professionals. However, he was informed that the Borough hired a new billing clerk for the Authority's operations. The Borough has not formally notified the Authority of the new hire as of this date.

### **ENGINEER**

Justin Mahon submitted report, which is on file and discussed the following items:

Discussion was held on 2 projects that will need to be addressed in the next 30 days: (1) Installation of a flusher/sampling station for the Authority's dead end main at Reservoir Drive to 03/11/19

satisfy NJDEP mandated sampling for water quality; (2) replacement or removal of a broken valve at intersection of Belmont Avenue and High Mountain Road.

Policy for estimated bills needs resolution prior to issuing Camp Veritans letter.

The Auditor advised that the financing funds for the 2018 Capital Improvements Project are still frozen. There are over 900 projects on the priority list. The Authority's projects are listed at #185 and #453. However, the environmental plan and bid specifications must be finalized for the projects to be considered for financing.

## **ATTORNEY**

Casey Cordes submitted report, which is on file and discussed the following items:

Water bill dispute has been received for 908 Belmont Avenue. Need to investigate matter and thereafter a response will be prepared.

### **AUDITOR**

Robert McNinch discussed the following:

The Audit is underway. There is a new requirement to schedule unfunded health benefits, which will likely not affect the Authority; however, it was taken under advisement.

## LICENSED OPERATOR

The February trihalomethane results were lower than prior years. The possible factors are the increased flushing or PVWC adjustments.

An alarm on March 5, 2019 at the Heights Tank was responded to and is still under review.

The Reservoir Pump Station Compressor failed so a temporary compressor was installed to maintain operation. The Operator recommended installation of a new control panel; however, the replacement is not critical.

The paperwork to complete the name change (Borough of Haledon to MUA) for the air permit for the old Filter Plant has been submitted to the NJDEP.
