He asks the residents to shovel around the first hydrants if possible in order to facilitate access to the hydrants in the event that they are needed.

The MUA followed-up with the users on Meserve Avenue and a leak was found along with a leak at the Manchester Avenue Pump Station. The staff has been working to address both.

He thanks the users on Meserve Avenue for bringing the issues to the Board's attention.

The MUA is investigating updating the Capital Improvement Plan since the last one is quite old and several projects within that plan have been completed. The contract proposal will be discussed in Executive Session.

One of the MUA's new vehicles was hit while parked. The damage cost is \$1,400.00. The vehicle will be fixed and thankfully no one was injured.
