He explained that the Bond Counsel proposals were rejected at the last meeting due to the pricing proposals being unclear. A new Request for Qualifications was advertised, which was clearer as to the MUA's needs. The new proposals will be considered at the April meeting.

The MUA is on schedule for NJEIT financing for the 2014 Water Improvement System project. There was a fire on Roe Street. He thanked all parties involved in getting the fire under control. The Fire Chief indicated that it was difficult to find the hydrant due to the snow cover. He asked residents to do their part in clearing the hydrants so that the firefighters can have access to them. Bids on portable radios should be forthcoming. Joanne is looking into pricing under the State Contract as well.
