REPORTS AND DISCUSSION

CHAIRMAN

Victor D'Ambrosio spoke on the following:

Upcoming maintenance projects will begin- Leak Detection to start the end of April.

Hydrant flushing has been moved up a week, to start week of April 4, 2011 and will take approximately 2 weeks. This may cause low water pressure.

He suggests residents run faucets and drain water heaters. Even though water may be brown, it is safe to use.

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5 Hydrants have been identified and will be replaced.

Valve replacement will be done in-house.

The roof needs to be replaced at the Central Avenue Pump Station. This is a project that may be done with USDA grant monies.

Central Avenue Tank needs to be cleaned up and painted. This project may also be done with USDA grant monies.

NJEIT financing offer in the Fall was discussed. In the Spring of 2012 formal documents would need to be submitted with the monies to be received in Fall of 2012 and work completed in Spring of 2013. The costs and future debt service need to be discussed prior to deciding to pursue this financing.

He met with Angelo to formulate a 1-3 year plan to address needed improvements to the system. The discussed the possible purchase of valve turning equipment so that this maintenance can be done in-house. Angelo felt this is a possibility with an annual program and the right equipment.

A user had a problem with the line but the problem was fixed by Borough personnel and now the homeowner is disputing the bill.

An OPRA request was received and addressed to the best of the staff's ability and in accordance with applicable state law.

A .966% credit was issued to certain users for the billing effective date on the increased rates.

The Website is being re-examined to include more information. However, for now, the 2011 Rate Schedule and Budget can be accessed there.

There is a need to re-examine the MUA's Rules and Regulations, By-Laws, and Operating Procedures. He would like to form a Committee to focus on this task and make recommendations to the MUA. The professionals will be included in this task; however, he will obtain estimates from them in order to keep the costs within budget.
