REPORTS AND DISCUSSION

CHAIRMAN

Victor D'Ambrosio spoke on the following:

During the snowstorm, one of the MUA's trucks was damaged. The Borough of Haledon is in the process of getting quotes and the Borough will pay for costs associated with the damage since it was done when the truck was being used for snowplowing versus MUA activities.

He wants to send a letter to the Dialysis Center in North Haledon suggesting that they obtain an emergency back-up system in the event that one is needed to provide service for their patients in the event of any emergency shutdown of the MUA's water service.

The lowest bidder for the Emergency Service Repair Contract was John Garcia Construction. The MUA has not worked with this company before but it is a large company with vast experience working with public entities.

He sent a letter to the North Haledon Tax Collector notifying her of the MUA's water service liens in the Borough of North Haledon.

He advised that the 2014 Water Improvement Project should be closed out soon. The final paving is expected to happen within the next month.

ENGINEER

Justin Mahon submitted report, which is on file and addressed any questions.

He also highlighted the following items:

ARCADIS prepared the Emergency Service Repair bid tabulation and found that John Garcia Construction was the lowest bidder. ARCADIS submitted a written recommendation to award the Contract to John Garcia Construction.

ARCADIS prepared a report concerning the application for 361 Squaw Brook Road, which recommended approval subject to certain conditions.

The 2014 Water Improvement Project was discussed. The final paving should occur next week.

ATTORNEY

Casey Cordes submitted report, which is on file and addressed any questions.

Counsel provided a written recommendation to award the Emergency Service Repair Contract to John Garcia Construction as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

AUDITOR

He advised that the MUA's laboratory proficiency testing have been received and were found acceptable to the NJDEP Office of Quality Assurance.

The Lead and Copper Sampling Plan efforts are proceeding. Testing has started but the process is slow. Approximately 7-8 households have been tested as of the date of the meeting.

The firm is now working on a Water Quality Sampling Plan as per the NJDEP's requirement despite the fact that the MUA does not complete corrosion control treatment. That service is performed by Passaic Valley Water Commission.
