NJ DEP inspected site and noted some items that need to be addressed at the filter plant. Most of the noted items were already planned to be addressed within the next month. MUA to consider future Capital Improvement Projects.

MUA looking for a new bank to do its business with since the old bank is now charging bank fees. Valley National Bank submitted a proposal for consideration.

The MUA needs to address the Escrow Accounts procedure. It was discussed and decided that the MUA shall release Escrow Accounts being held by Borough of Haledon and establish individual MUA accounts in the future.

Leak detection is moving forward. The current contractor will not be able to perform 100% of the system due to his scheduling conflicts. This phase of the work is to detect the leaks and the next phase that needs to be addressed is funding the repairs that will be needed based upon his findings.
