CHAIRMAN

Victor D'Ambrosio spoke on the following:

He thanks Commissioner Van Sickle for running the MUA meeting last month.

Hydrant flushing will begin and run for the next 3 weeks. The flushing may cause users to experience some brown water. He advises that this is a temporary condition and suggests that residents run faucets and drain hot water heaters.

Last month the board members passed the 2011 Capital Improvement Project.

He advised that the Senior Citizen Discount that was initially raised by the Mayor of North Haledon is still being considered for next year.

He is awaiting a response from the representatives involved at 485 Belmont Avenue.

TREASURER

No report at this time.

SUPERINTENDENT

Angelo Passafaro submitted report and is on file.

He reported that the DPW is now on a scheduled rotation of 3 days/ 2 days every two weeks splitting Borough and MUA duties.

ENGINEER

Justin Mahon submitted report and is on file.

Draft of Environmental Plan Report discussed.

The Leak Detection Project is completed. Fourteen leaks were detected, one third of all leaks were on customer side. He suggested sending a letter to customers who are affected by these leaks as to their options for repair.

Overall discussion held on 2011 Capital Improvements Project.

Central Avenue Tank – cost is approximately \$820,000

Valve Work and Leak Detection – cost is approximately \$200,000

Superintendent recommends reading entire system to compare usage vs. purchase

He recommended approval of the 525 Belmont Avenue connection subject to the conditions set forth in his letter.

He recommended the approval of the John Ryle Street connection subject to the conditions set forth in his letter.

NJDEP has requested paying off loan amount of \$6,879 for the Hawthorne Interconnection since that project was not completed. The Auditor represented that this amount is available out of the Water Operating Account and budget in order to make this payment.
